Hosted by EURAM Vice President Kathrin M. Moeslein and EURAM National Representative for Germany Anne-Katrin Neyer, in cooperation with the German research alliance 'BALANCE' led by Kathrin M. Moeslein and Angelika Bullinger, this developmental consortium is designed for early career academics (i.e., within six years of the completion of their PhD, or of equivalent professional standing).

The focus of the first consortium is on "open research: innovation and cooperation". We wish to start an academic conversation about social interactions, organizational practices and processes, technological support, innovation processes and individual interests as well as cooperative behaviour.
