Following the three earlier successful EURAM Early Career Colloquia held in Dublin, Innsbruck and Nuremberg, the “Early Career Community” is pleased to announce that the **4th EURAM Early Career Colloquium (EECC) will be hosted by University of Liechtenstein, Institute for Entrepreneurship** from the **30th January to 1st February 2013**.

The aim of the EECC is to offer a platform for early career academics (defined as assistant professors, post-doctoral researchers, recently appointed lecturers/associate professors) to come together to discuss key challenges, learn from experts and share career related insights. The EECC provides a forum for networking, knowledge exchange and development of research collaborations.

The 4th EECC is delighted to welcome you to Vaduz, Principality of Liechtenstein in the heart of Europe situated between Switzerland and Austria, snow-covered mountains and sunny valleys. The EECC will be hosted by University of Liechtenstein Institute for Entrepreneurship. The nearest large international airport is in Zurich-Kloten. Regional airports are located in St. Gallen-Altenrhein (approx. 40km, Switzerland), Friedrichshafen (approx 80 km, Germany) and Innsbruck (approx. 200 km, Austria). Trains from these airports travel to Buchs and Sargans (Switzerland) and Feldkirch (Austria), from where you have a direct bus connection to Vaduz.

The theme of the Liechtenstein EECC is “**Finding Your Place in Academia**”. Key sessions will build on this theme covering the domains of career opportunities, publication and reviewer expectations, challenges of the academic profession and funding body expectations as well as work-life balance.
